HEALTHY GUIDELINES

IN ALL CASES OF ACCIDENT OR EMERGENCY, or if you are uncertain of what to do, call 911. Be calm and thorough while speaking with emergency dispatch. Do not hang up the phone until instructed to do so. Do not compromise rescuer safety. Do not give liquids to an unconscious person. Do not move victim unless they are in an unsafe location and doing so will not cause injury to the rescuer or further injury to the victim. Do not provide aid unless appropriate gloves and personal protection are worn.

BREATHING PROBLEMS: If patient is choking and unable to breathe, relieve obstruction by administering abdominal thrusts. If breathing stops or appears to be irregular call 911. If victim is non-responsive, begin hands-only CPR if safe and trained to do so. Do not stop compressions or leave the victim alone unless necessary to find help.

BLEEDING WOUNDS: Have victim apply direct pressure over wound with sterile bandage. Add bandages as needed to control bleeding but do not remove used bandages from wound. Do not remove embedded objects. For minor cuts, clean with sterile water or saline and cover with sterile bandage. Call 911.

BURNS: Cool burn with tepid or cool clean water being careful not to drop the victim's body temperature. Remove all jewelry and affected clothing. Cover the injury with a clean dry pad or cloth and call physician. For any burn that results in blistering or broken skin, call 911. Do not apply creams, ointments, or ice to the burn. Creams that are specifically designed for use with burns can be used as long as manufacturer instructions are followed. Call 911 for any burn or exposure to the eyes, nose, or mouth.
